CODE OF CONDUCT CHARTER

A CONFERENCE COMMITTED TO COMBATING VIOLENCE, DISCRIMINATION AND HARASSMENT

As participants in the international conference of the French Society of Sport Psychology, we firmly commit to promoting inclusion, combating all forms of discrimination, violence and harassment, and contributing to a safe, respectful and welcoming environment for all participants.

We acknowledge that scientific events may be influenced by power dynamics and may become spaces where various forms of violence (class-based, racist, sexual, sexist, etc.) can occur. We are aware that discriminatory behaviour is not only illegal under criminal law but also contrary to professional and academic standards.

By signing this code of conduct charter, you commit to:

- Raising awareness and respecting other participants, by avoiding discriminatory or violent behaviour based on social origin, sexual orientation, gender identity, age, disability, beliefs, socio-economic status, physical appearance, or any other grounds of discrimination.
- Using respectful language in all interactions, whether during presentations, discussions or informal exchanges. This includes addressing linguistic forms of violence such as monopolising speaking time or dismissing colleagues' contributions during sessions.
- Using our voice and position to promote inclusion, equality and mutual respect within the professional community.

Reporting any cases of discrimination or violence directly to the support persons designated by the organising committee. Reports will be handled confidentially, impartially and respectfully.

We acknowledge that the organising committee of the 2026 SFPS international conference will provide listening support and guidance if needed.
